Seal of Approval Guidelines

Only approved versions of the Washington State Board of Pharmacy “seal of approval” shall be used.

- The “seal of approval” must appear in its entirety – graphic and text together every time it is used. Do not edit the type, change the typeface or insert extra words.
- The “seal of approval” should never be combined with other logos.
- The format of the seal:
 - Washington State outline map is center within a mortar and pestle watermark
 - Washington State outline map is printed in green thermo-chromic ink, which must change from green to yellow when exposed to heat or friction and back to green when cooled.
 - Sizing: Mortar and Pestle – W x H = 1.125" x 1.125"
 - Washington State with text – W x H = .625"
- Placement: Lower right-hand corner of the prescription form.

Note: prescription forms on board-approved tamper-resistant prescription paper and pads must include two signature lines at opposite ends of the bottom of the form. Under the line on the right-side the words

“DISPENSE AS WRITTEN” must clearly be printed. Under the line on the left side the word

“SUBSTITUTION PERMITTED” must clearly be printed. (RCW 69.41.120).
